An all new Cost Management Life Cycle table is included showing the basis / documentation requirements and LCC interfaces and deliverables related to standard Cost Management activities across the three (3) life-cycle phases of Design, Construction and Asset / Facilities Management. These three (3) phases are further broken down into a framework covering ten (10) project life stages. This LCC work complements our contributions to the 2020 RICS Technical Due Diligence and 2020 RICS Cost Prediction guides.
