
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ISO 41000 series: **COVID-19**

- □ ISO 55001 Asset Management is primarily focused upon the physical infrastructure, whilst ISO 41001 Facility Management is primarily focused upon the operational performance. For AM / FM there will be **crossover**, **integration and complementary points** relative to organizational culture and life cycle.

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
