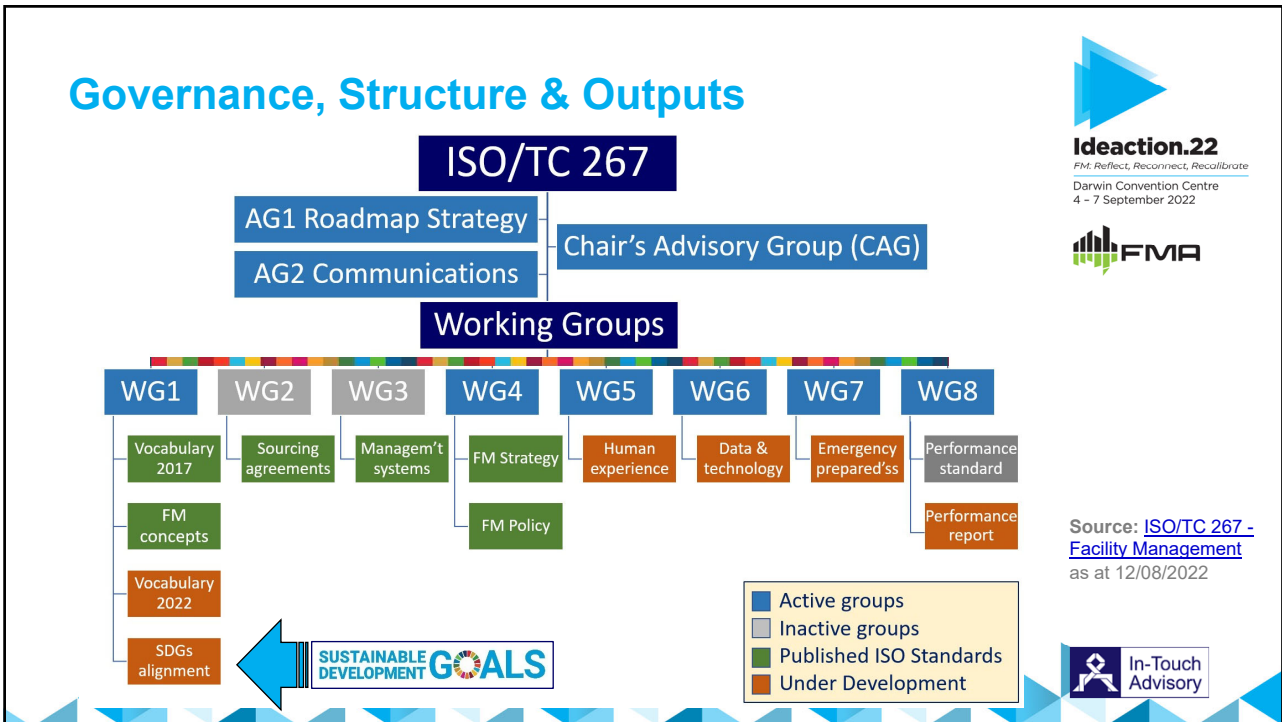
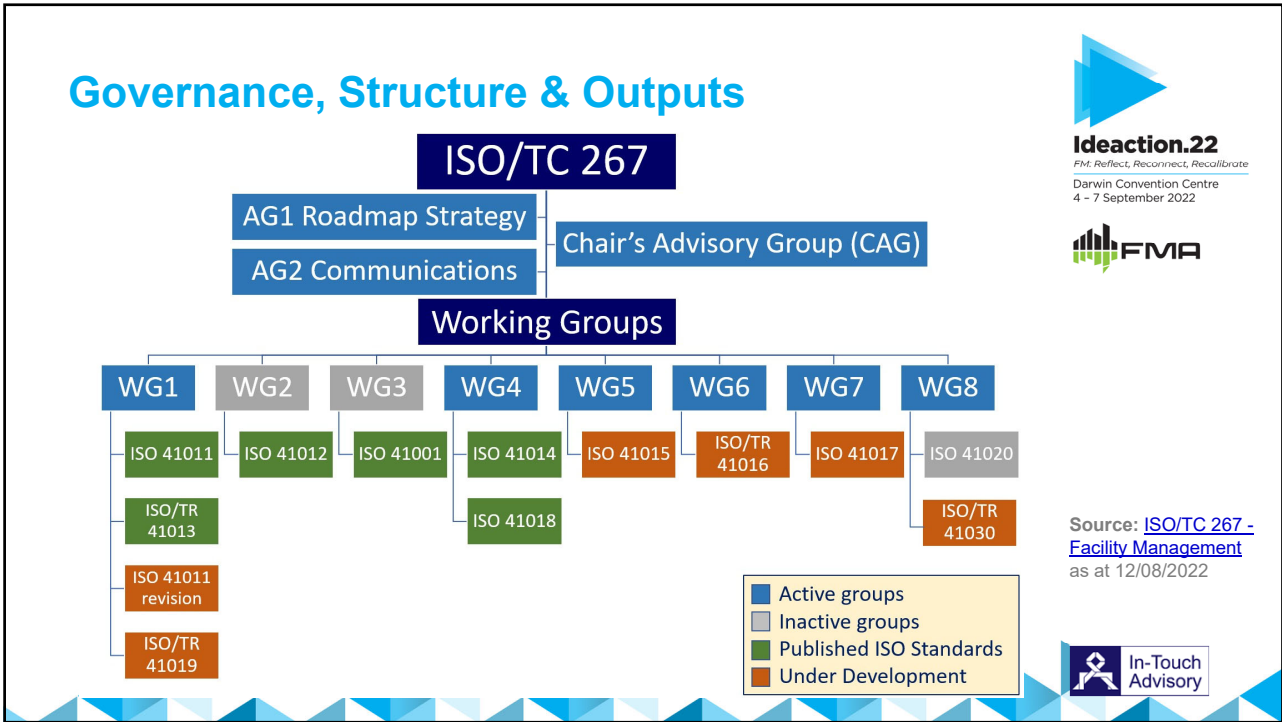


FM is an "organizational function which integrates people, place and process within the **Built Environment** with the purpose of improving the **quality of life** of people and the **productivity** of the core business"

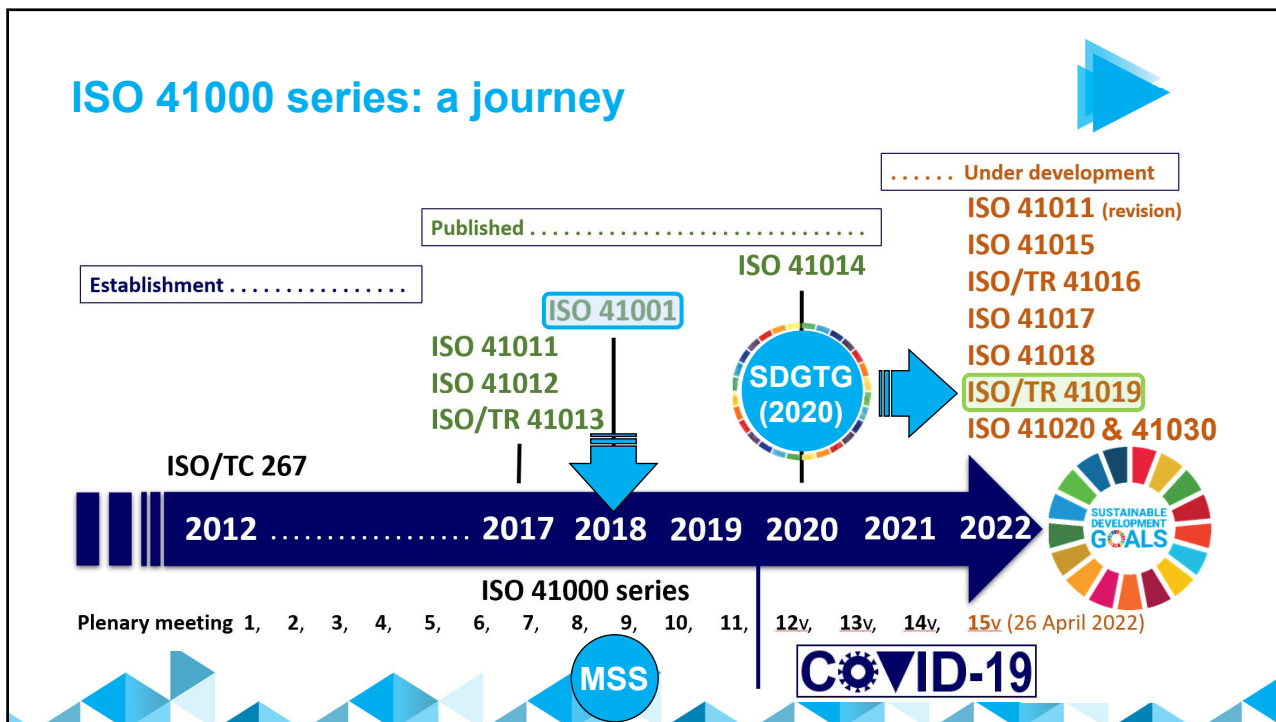

ISO 41001 – certification options

ISO develop Standards, but are **not** involved in their certification.

This is performed by, and certificates issued by, external certification bodies, refer [IAF Certification Bodies - Search](#).

‘Certification’ can be achieved via three (3) forms of audit:

- Third-party** audits are external, and conducted by a certification body. A third-party audit is required for ISO’s Committee on Conformity Assessment ([CASCO](#)) accredited certification.
- Second-party** audits are also external, but managed internally via either the Demand Organization or FM Organization auditing service providers and suppliers.
- First-party** audits are internal, and better described as ‘self-assessment’ or ‘self-declaration’.

ISO 41001 – certification options

Demand Organization is the "entity which has a need and the authority to incur costs to have requirements met" (ISO 41011: 2017)

FM Organization as an "entity responsible for facility management" (ISO 41014: 2020)

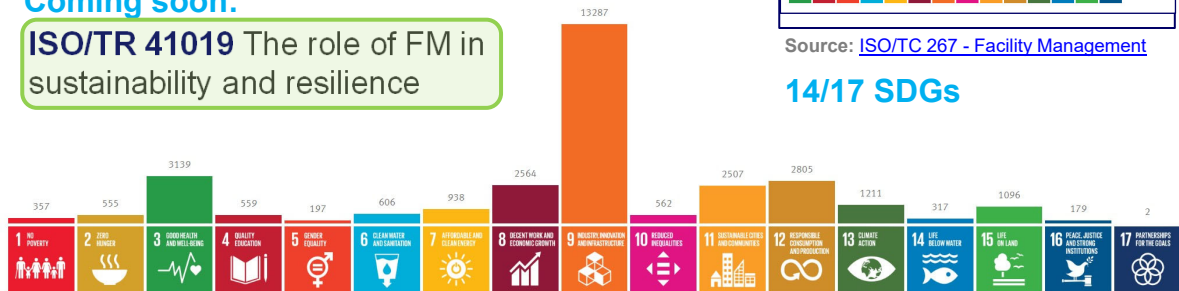

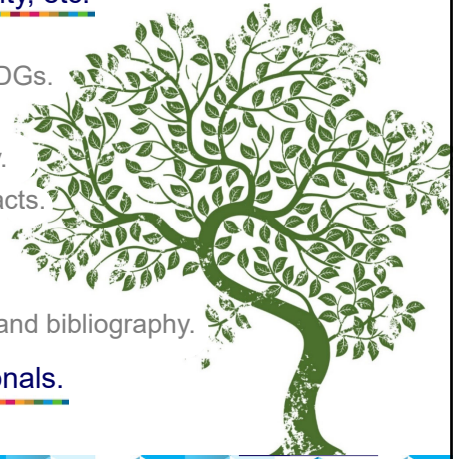

- ❑ **Status:** research and drafting is underway, planned publication late 2023.
- ❑ **Scope:** FM's role in sustainability, resilience, adaptability, etc.
 - Introduction, terms and definitions.
 - Concepts, context, challenges, climate change, and the SDGs.
 - Role of ISO standards in supporting the SDGs.
 - FM and SDGs for sustainability, resilience and adaptability.
 - FM defined per ISO 41011, and SDGs alignment and impacts.
 - Role of current and planned ISO 41000 series standards.

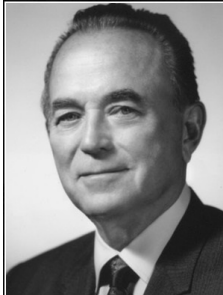
