

IFMA Fellows Asia-Pacific



IFMA established the Fellowship program in **1992** to recognize distinguished members with achievements and dedication to IFMA and the facility management profession.

Only 0.5% of the IFMA membership may hold the title of "**IFMA Fellow**".

Between 3 - 11 conferred p.a. since 1992.

As of 2025, IFMA has recognized a total of **140 IFMA Fellows**. Of these, 52 are Emeritus, leaving only **88 active IFMA Fellows worldwide**.


Currently we have **9 IFMA Fellows based in APAC**, shown here by location and year of elevation.

Since 2002 there have been a total of 14 IFMA Fellows recognized within our region.

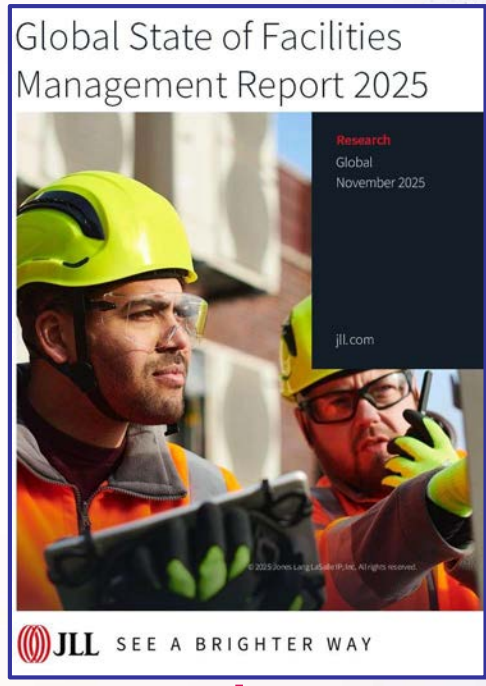

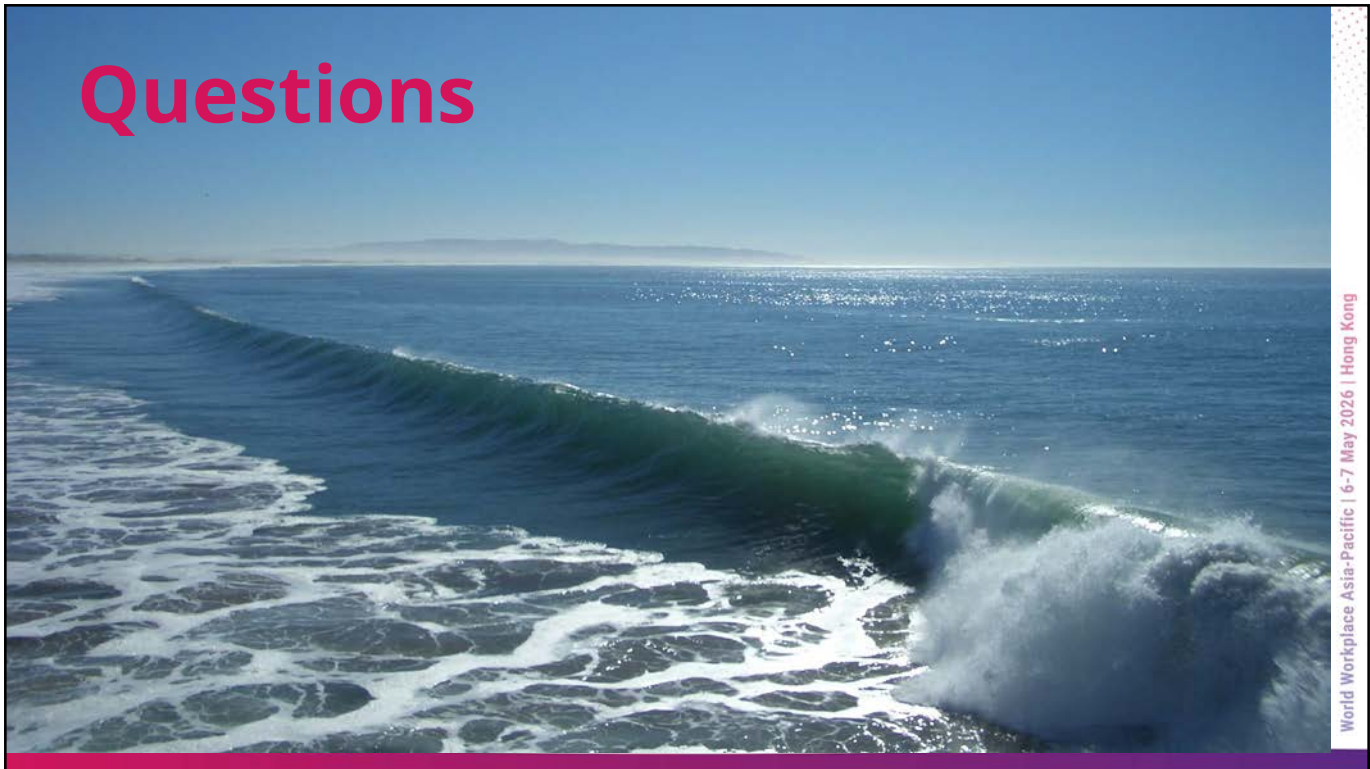
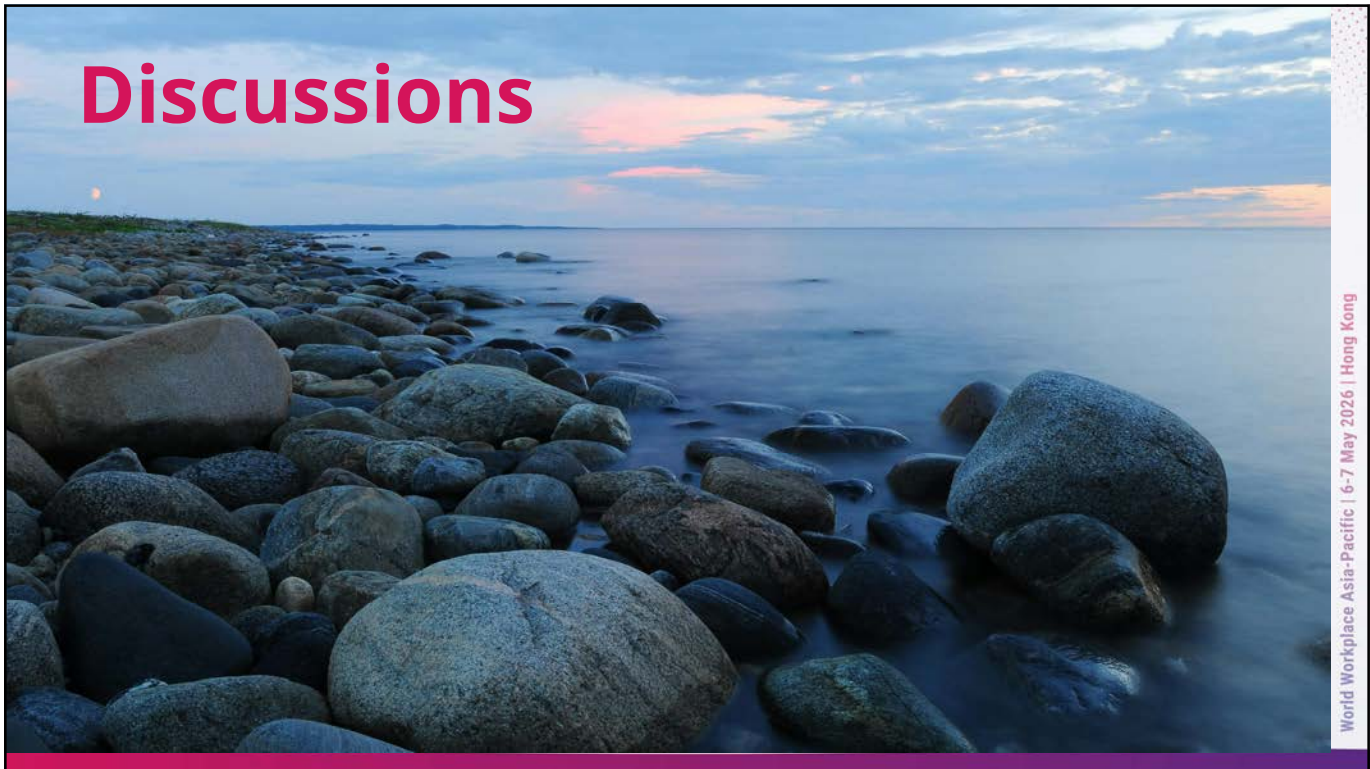
